Consultancy Services



PLD provides an Australian, evidence-based approach to Structured Synthetic Phonics (SSP) for primary school educators. Aligned with the Science of Reading, PLD's SSP approach extends from the junior primary years through to upper primary years and thereby facilitating a whole school approach.

PLD offers a range of training options. Each of the training options focus on the implementation of PLD's evidence-based Structured Synthetic Phonics (SSP) programs and processes within schools. The training is designed for teachers, support staff, school leaders and educational assistants working within primary schools.

Coaching Sessions

Following the attendance at PLD presentations it is common for teachers, school leaders or committees to require further guidance. These sessions allow for questions to be answered and policies to be revised. Schools to specify the topics and are \$330 per hour excluding GST and are typically small group sessions.



 Minimum time allocation 3 hours but ideally a full day.
- A Whole School Approach To Oral Language
 (i.e. a language based program that supports the writing and reading comprehension basis of literacy).

 Minimum time allocation 3 hours but ideally a full day.

Schools may also request variations on the above topics that reflect special needs.
