Test Questions

1. (Level 3) **This family have a pet dog. Tell me another pet they could have.**

Tick	Student's response:	
	Adequate response	A cat; a mouse; a fish; a rabbit; a guinea pig.
	Inadequate response	A dog; names an animal that can not be a pet; we have a dog too.

2. (Level 3) **Point to one of the people in the picture but not a girl or a lady.**

Tick	Student's response:	
	Adequate response	Points to the boy or the dad.
	Inadequate response	Points to a girl, the lady or something else.

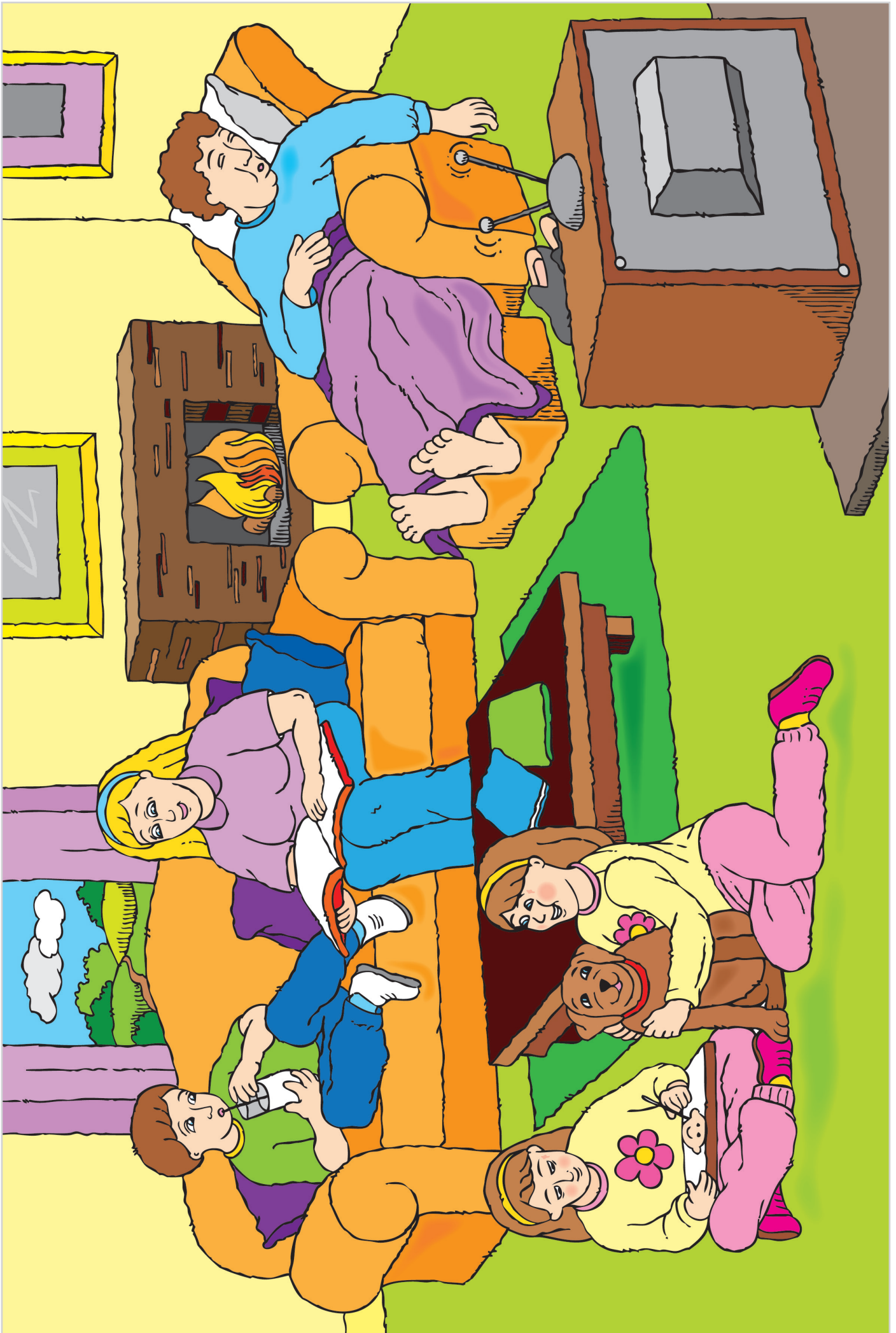
3. (Level 4) **How can we tell that the girls are twins?**

Tick	Student's response:	
	Adequate response	They look the same; they are the same size/age.
	Inadequate response	They are together; she is drawing.

4. (Level 4) **How do you know that Dad is tired?**

Tick	Student's response:	
	Adequate response	Because he's asleep; because he is sleeping on the chair.
	Inadequate response	He is very tired; he has worked hard; he is there; his eyes are closed.
