- ▶ Typically students start to read 1st, spell 2nd and write 3rd.
- ▶ This course demonstrates instruction that is explicit and time efficient.
- ▶ Videos 1 & 2 outline the teaching, screening and small group work required within term 1 & 2.
- ▶ Video 3 outlines how to cater for the range in ability as students begin to progress at different levels.
- ▶ Video 4 focuses upon the teaching of writing and also how to finalise the school year.

- ▶ Synthetic Phonics is the most effective method of early literacy instruction. The course outlines PLD's structured synthetic phonics approach when students are operating at a Year 1 or 2 level.
- ▶ Videos 1 and 2 focus upon the assessment process to establish the ability groupings, while video 3 focuses upon the beginnings of explicit instruction. The final video outlines the weekly spelling process and how to present regular dictation sessions.

Note: if the Year 1 class has particularly weak students, the following online course is also relevant.

This course outlines the teaching, screening and management of students entering classes who are unable to read, spell and write.



Teaching students unable to read, spell and write within primary school

- ▶ Synthetic Phonics and beyond briefly outlines the junior primary process before progressing into mature spelling levels and characteristics of students operating at a relatively age appropriate middle and upper primary level.
- ▶ The focus of this course is to establish a time efficient process addition to the literacy block of instruction which caters for the typically huge range in ability.

through the medium of dictation



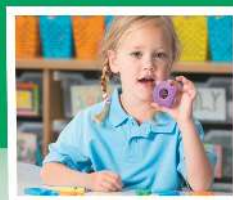
