Professional Learning

PLD offers school-based professional development modules on the following topics.

Junior Primary Presentations

- Preparation For Literacy (i.e. the alphabet, phono-logical awareness and oral language).
 Minimum time allocation 3 hours but ideally a full day
- Teaching students to read, spell and write in the junior years. Minimum time allocation 3 hours but ideally a full day.

Whole School Presentations

- A Whole School Approach To Spelling/Synthetic Phonics. *Minimum time allocation 3 hours but ideally a full day.*
- A Whole School Approach To Oral Language (i.e. a language based program that supports the writing and reading comprehension basis of literacy). *Minimum time allocation 3 hours but ideally a full day.*
- Literacy And Special Needs. Minimum time allocation a full day.
- The Management Of Literacy And Academic Difficulties *Minimum time allocation a full day.*
- Raising Writing Standards. *Minimum time allocation 3 hours but ideally a full day.*

Schools may also request variations on the above topics that reflect special needs.

Multiple Schools Attending

2 schools - 10% discount, 3 schools - 20% discount, 4 schools - 30% discount Example: If 5 schools gather for a full day PD, each school will receive a 40% discount ($1200 \times 40\% = 480$) so 720 will be billed, by PLD, directly to each school involved.

Regional Presentations

Organisers need to supply the PLD office with prior information. On the basis of the total estimated number of attendees, a quote outlining the cost (per head) will be calculated.
